- Providing supervision to Certified Nursing Assistants (CNAs) / Patient Care Advocates (PCAs)
- Provides direct nursing care to patients with select disorders of the gastrointestinal, genitourinary and integumentary systems in accordance with established policies, procedures and protocols of the healthcare organization
- Nurse will be based out of home or office after successfully completing training and meeting specific metrics, with possible travel required to assigned hospitals and facilities
- Provides quality patient care to patients on voluntary inpatient unit
- Administers medications, provides wound care, monitors patients for medication efficacy and symptom improvement
