Responsibilities for RN lactation consultant

- Review procedure(s) as requested
- Share new knowledge at a unit/staff meeting
- Initiate and monitor clinical pathways where appropriate
- Initiate discharge planning upon admission
- Implement prescribed treatment and nursing plan of care on a regular basis
- Provides follow up for patients who have discussed lactation concerns with staff nurses and need additional consultation with a lactation consultant
- Acts as a visible lactation resource to promote lactation services, breastfeeding education and breast pump sales
- Promote evidence-based practice and quality initiatives and exhibits professionalism in nursing practice
- Be willing to flex to Postpartum unit as needed
- Actively anticipates patient's and/or patient's family needs and expectations and utilizes these in conjunction with the assessment to develop an appropriate plan of care for the patient

- IBCLC certification is preferred and required within 12 months of employment
