Responsibilities for RN NICU

- Assist other staff members in providing direct patient care in times of increased census or workload
- Use downtime effectively to assist others, accomplish assigned projects and volunteers for additional tasks
- Support management's guidelines and objectives regarding fiscal budget goals both verbally and behaviorally
- Coordinate assigned patient's activities with other nursing and non-nursing departments to ensure uninterrupted patient care
- Arrive on time to work in a consistent manner, to be present at morning report sessions and be ready to provide clinical services to obstetric patients
- Adhere to established hospital attendance policy
- Other duties as assigned within nursing scope of practice
- Maintain an effective interdepartmental and public relationship by keeping lines of communication open
- Anticipate needs of the team and ensures smooth operational flow (i.e., transports patients to OR to meet scheduled start time, transfers patients to postpartum)
- Initiate problem resolution for identified opportunities for improvement or difficult interpersonal situations

Qualifications for RN NICU

- More than 1 year of experience and meet the department specific

- NRP certification or obtained as soon as possible after hire
- One year of RN experience in a level II or Level III nursery
- Two to five year of acute care RN NICU experience in a level II or Level III nursery
- Ability to perform nursing duties required for assigned clinical setting
