Responsibilities for RN, practice

- Assist with orienting of newly hired medical assistants
- Accurately and in a timely manner
- Assists with general clerical duties as needed or directed
- Maintains supplies and medications appropriately
- Assists with general clerical duties as needed or directed by the Practice Manager
- Examines clients to obtain information about their physical condition
- Administers or orders diagnostic tests, such as x-ray, electrocardiogram, and laboratory tests
- Instructs and counsels clients about prescribed therapeutic regimens, normal growth and development, family planning, emotional problems of daily living, and health maintenance
- Makes tentative diagnoses and decisions about management and treatment of clients
- Obtains, compiles and records client medical data, including health history, progress notes and results of physical examination

- RNs Certification in Ambulatory Nursing through the AACN, or strongly preferred
- Other applicable nursing certifications may be considered if applicable for this role
- Associate's degree as RN
