## Responsibilities for RN program coordinator

- Coordination of Prevention & Management of Disruptive Behavior (PMDB)
  training for the Kansas City VA Medical Center employees
- Collaborates with facility leadership to ensure facility policies are compliant with The Joint Commission (TJC) and Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) requirements regarding workplace violence prevention training
- Prepares, reviews, and submits national reports regarding assignment and completion of PMDB training
