Responsibilities for rn-radiology

- Implementing the pre-operative admission assessment record, assimilation of the patient's hospital record, and obtaining history and physical from ordering physician's office
- Implementing the nursing process performing assessment, reassessment, sedation monitoring and related needed testing and providing patient safety, comfort, and privacy at all times
- Coordinates patient care for physicians and other departments to insure patient safety and compliance of physicians orders
- Implements appropriate patient interventions and evaluates outcomes
- Provides holistic, comprehensive, and professional nursing care to patient within the scope of practice
- Comply with all agency policies, procedures, practices and standards of care
- Admit new patients according to agency procedure
- Organize and implement individualized patient care based on ongoing interpretation of physiological, psychological and sociological deficits affecting the state of health
