Responsibilities for rn-radiology

- Provide weekend and holiday coverage as assigned by the Administrator
- Participate in the review process
- Report pertinent observations to attending physician
- Completes related tasks as assigned by the Patient Care Supervisor/Administrator
- The Registered Nurse will be trained on PICC and Mid-Line IV insertion
- Participates in monthly staff meeting for assigned unit
- Assists the Nurse Leader or designee, with updates and maintains unit records, reports, and forms
- Assists in preparing monthly schedule for assigned unit
- Assist with performance appraisals/corrective action and counseling
- Provides required documentation for personnel file in a timely manner

Qualifications for rn-radiology

- Able to assess, plan, implement and evaluate nursing care
- Two to three years experience in Interventional Radiology nursing or Critical Care nursing preferred
- Minimum of one (1) year in a critical care area (i.e., Intensive Care Unit, Emergency Department, Interventional Radiology)
- ADN or BSN preferred
- Full range of body motion to lift, walk and move patients, complete bimanual dexterity, eye-hand coordination and binocular vision corrected to 20/30,

- No pacemaker, insulin pump, or other MR sensitive medical device, or implanted metallic prosthetic device large enough to disrupt the static 1.5 Tesla field
