## Responsibilities for rn-radiology

- Provides leadership to staff in accurately discriminating among multiple veteran problems/systems issues and to focus on problem areas
- Ensures assessments and reassessments are accurately and timely documented
- Adheres to HIPPA guidelines
- Analyzes resource utilization to assure safe, effective and appropriate veteran care delivery
- Actively problem-solves within nursing and other disciplines to solve veteran care issues
- Provides appropriate patient care and treatment utilizing the nursing process, and ensures information related to changes in patient's condition is relayed accurately and efficiently to the physician
- Prepare patients for procedures including pre- procedure instruction, pre-procedure assessments, intravenous access, and accurate documentation
- Provides intra-procedure monitoring and sedation according to departmental protocols and physician direction
- Facilitate and ensure safety of patient until transferred to post-procedural recovery unit
- Acts as a patient advocate for patient and family members
