



Example of Route Driver Job Description

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Our innovative and growing company is searching for experienced candidates for the position of route driver. We appreciate you taking the time to review the list of qualifications and to apply for the position. If you don't fill all of the qualifications, you may still be considered depending on your level of experience.

Responsibilities for route driver

- Immediately notify the Area BevCarb Manager of malfunctioning equipment or condition that need immediate action
- May visit between 8–10 customer sites per day
- Loading and unloading trucks and assisting with warehouse duties as necessary
- Will be responsible for operating vacuum truck and picking up waste oil at customer locations driving a Class B Tanker Truck
- Deliver chemicals in 15 & 30 gallon drums in a Class B Box Truck
- Timely submit all customer paperwork, including invoices, load orders, and handheld reports
- Complete assigned route and tasks within DOT time regulations and ensure rest time requirements are observed
- Initially work in warehouse and learn the business
- Next begin to shadow our Route Drivers who are responsible for delivering chemicals in 15 & 30 gallon drums in a Class A Dry Van or Class B Box Truck
- Eventually our Utility Representatives would cover routes for the Drivers when needed

Qualifications for route driver

- One year of CDL driving experience or graduated from an accredited truck driving school with a score of 80 percent or better

- Class C License (Class B CDL with HAZMAT preferred but will train if you do not have)
- Must be able to overnight travel up to 50%
- 2+ years in a similar role, industrial experience preferred
- Must be able to clear a background check and pass a drug screen and pre-employment physical
