Responsibilities for safety leader

- Support the Safety Manager in the day-to-day operations of the safety department
- Ensure compliance with Corporate and Mill safety and health guidelines
- Stay informed and up-to-date with changing corporate and regulatory changes, including but not limited to, corporate directives and initiatives
- Provide technical support to operating departments and support areas to ensure regulatory compliance
- Consults on Safety Management System (SMS) design and compliance
- Support the Safety Manager and participate in worker compensation claims, accident investigations, contractor safety orientation, employee safety training, and process improvement initiatives
- Serve as a liaison for mill safety committees
- Provides coordination of the Mill's fire prevention activities/requirements
- Coordinate volunteer programs for the mill's EMTs, Incipient Fire Brigade, and first responder emergency response personnel
- Coordinate annual fire system inspections with the Mill's insurance provider

Qualifications for safety leader

- At least 5 years of practical experience with SHE Pillar implementation, preferably with exposure to global excellence awards or similar level of implementation
- Minimum ten (10) years of experience in business process redesign,

- Minimum seven (7) years of experience managing or leading projects, data analysis or a team of analysts/consultants
