



Example of Safety Leader Job Description

Responsibilities for safety leader

- Develop and update mill-wide safety KPI's and communicate status routinely
- Use MillCat reporting system regularly as a mill-wide, real time communication and tracking tool
- May require light travel
- Manage and develop the sales team across the given region
- Responsible for sales and margin for the region
- Develop country sales plans whilst increasing the market share
- Work with team members to develop personal development plans and schedule regular reviews ensuring that local labor laws are adhered to at all times
- Ensure visibility on field by establishing long term business relationships with major business partners and participating in the major sales opportunities
- A part of sales team management tasks and country objectives, he/she will also run his/her personal and specific account plan and objectives
- Partner with business HSE resources to provide technical expertise on issues involving compliance with and interpretation of federal, state and local requirements, rules and regulations

Qualifications for safety leader

- Must possess superior interpersonal skills (oral and written), coaching and mentoring skills, presentation skills, and must exemplify key leadership

- Prefer Nursing experience (Periop.)
- Knowledge of learning software (Captivate, Lectora,) a plus but not mandatory
- Capable of leading a matrixed team comprised of scientists from within Takeda external collaborators
- Requires approximately 15% or more travel, including international travel monthly basis
