- Monitor computer and POS terminal physical security by executing standards, policies, and procedures
- Participate in project work sessions and assist in developing solutions leveraging core risk and security policies as they relate to Infrastructure security
- Investigates and responds to alarms, reported events, disturbances, or environmental concerns while coordinating actions with the Global Security Command Center
