Responsibilities for security director

- Plans and schedules fire, safety, and code pink drills
- Coordinates parking arrangements for all departments and employees
- Supervises all employees in the Security Department
- Oversees medical facility's interaction with U.S Postal Service
- Oversees HSE (Health, Safety and Environmental) plans, playbooks and procedures for the geographical region of responsibility
- Analyzes and improves availability, efficiency, capacity, scalability, security and performance of systems
- Documents and maintains information related to the information security program
- Manage, monitor, and oversee coordination of internal and 3rd party audits, review including allocating assignments and work load to best utilize resources, meet service objectives, and deliver quality customer service
- Mentors and serves as the point person for team members to lend expertise and provide support for day to day activities assigned projects
