- Respond and provide security support to all emergencies situations
- Provide professional development, coach and mentor team of Discrete Protection Agents and other direct reports
- Conduct audits and assessments of direct staff and buildings to ensure personnel are following proper policies and procedures
- Responsible for on-the-job training and providing guidance to personnel on a daily basis
- Supervisor is responsible for the overall communications between teams during a shift to ensure clear communications with the GSOC and proper escalations are followed
- Supervisors will perform any other duties assigned by Site Security Program Leads
- Will conduct briefings on daily activities, incidents, and any other relevant information for their assigned shift

Qualifications for security shift supervisor

- Provide delivery and receiving functions
- Must possess, or be able to obtain, state or county security licensing (as applicable)
- Minimum of 2 years of verifiable and successful security experience
- Minimum of 1 year of experience in a Security Control Room
- Minimum of 3 years security experience in a corporate setting, preferred
