Responsibilities for senior maintenance mechanic

- Acts a resource person for the Medical Center
- Maintains a clean and hazard free work area
- Diagnoses the source of equipment problems by observing equipment operation and employing trouble-shooting methods
- Dismantles equipment to gain access, and identifies the replacement parts needed to restore proper operation
- Examines dimensions, wear, and condition of parts to determine their usability
- Repairs and replaces defective parts
- Makes adjustments to equipment systems and controls to restore proper operation
- Starts equipment to test its performance and the success of repairs
- Initiates material requests for parts or purchase requisitions for parts and machines
- Required to be trained in proper handling of hazardous waste in accordance with 40 CFR 265.16

Qualifications for senior maintenance mechanic

- Strong attention to detail regarding documen-tation is a must
- Good communication skills both oral and writ-ten are a must

- Minimum (4) years of technical experience in all aspects of building engineering
- Working knowledge of equipment programmable logic controllers (PLCs) such as Allen Bradley, Rockwell, Delta V, Siemens
- Experience with Biopharmaceutical processing equipment including Autoclaves, glass washers, Process Water systems, Injection systems, Freeze Driers, Bioreactors, Steam in place systems, clean steam generators
