Responsibilities for senior maintenance mechanic

- May be required to be trained in 24 hour Emergency Response in accordance with 29 CFR 1910.120
- May be trained in Confined Space, First Aid, CPR, and Blood borne Pathogens or any other safety related training deemed necessary
- Contact vendors, research problems and potential components, order maintenance machine parts
- Develop and implement safety related improvements jointly with your supervisor
- Train other mechanics as requested
- Actively communicate throughout every day with the production operators regarding equipment or process issues
- Perform PM's on Manufacturing Process equipment corrective work orders
- Ensure planned inspections of facilities equipment and services are performed
- Coordinate with outside contractors as necessary
- Performs mid to expert level break-fix & preventative maintenance

Qualifications for senior maintenance mechanic

- You will have experience in central heating systems
- You will have experience in repaired equipment to be tested to insure

- You will have experience reviewing available as-built drawings from OBO or the Post POC, compare the documents to existing conditions at each facility during site visit, and make necessary red line changes to the document to reflect actual conditions at each facility
- Bachelor's degree (6 years of related experience may substitute for the degree)
- Knowledge and practice of Energy Supply and OSHA/safety procedures
- Must have extensive knowledge of cGMP compliance
