Responsibilities for service mechanic

- Coordinate and perform clean-out and preparation of unoccupied building spaces
- Work with contracted service providers to oversee jobs, address escalations and facilitate their mobilization and demobilization
- Provide back-up support for the General Service Porter and assist Porter on jobs too large for one person
- Familiarity with Fire Extinguisher inspections, emergency/exit light inspections, escalations and record keeping activities
- Making temporary or permanent repairs on mains, services, stations, and other piping
- Making temporary or permanent repairs to other underground structures as directed
- Tapping pressurized piping
- Measuring, cutting, and threading pipe
- Making up mechanical, threaded, compression, and other types of joints
- Sandblasting joints, pipes, fittings, structures

Qualifications for service mechanic

- Requires Standing 95% of the work day
- Must be able to use hands to handle, control or feel objects and tools
- Requires repetitive movements

- Requires pushing/pulling
