Responsibilities for sewing machine operator

- Sew clothes using sewing machine or other stitching machines (Single Needle, Overlock, etc)
- Inspect finished product and do finishing touches
- Hand stitch edges or linings
- Cutting flame retardant material
- Sewing together gloves
- Inspection-nipping loose threads
- Set up jobs safely to make quality parts
- Read and interpret drawings and routings to determine requirements such as size of material, type of material, and quantity
- Operate Industrial sewing machine to join, gather, hem, reinforce, finish or decorate product such as patient kits, based on technical instructions that meet company standards
- Select supplies such as binding, braid, cord, piping, tape, thread, or welt according to specifications or color of material

Qualifications for sewing machine operator

- Seamstress experience and/or training preferred
- Must pass pre-employment drug screening
- Can sit, bend neck, and rotate around the workstation for an extended period of time

- Must have high school diploma/GED or equivalent (equivalent is defined as manufacturing work experience OR combination of education and manufacturing work experience)
- Ability to frequently lift/move material weighing up to 50 pounds
