- Oversee EDAS Staff and support functions for off-campus Emergency
 Department and urgent care sites including facilities, equipment and supplies
- Ensure adequate staffing levels at all times
- Meet quality metrics developed by Operations Manager, such as co-pay collection targets, registration accuracy
- Function as ED Access Specialist if needed to meet staffing levels
- Follow and support manufacturing or departmental activities of the site business plan with minimal guidance, deploy and communicate goals, objectives and performance measures related to area of responsibility
- Supervise employees within a mill department or production team
- May participate in cross-functional teams, such as production meetings, safety committee and site business teams
