Responsibilities for shift tech

- Work with Lab Tech II and Lab Lead to receive training, use the QMS software to access and acknowledge training documents and instructions
- Follow standard procedures regarding sample preparation prior to instrumental analysis
- Demonstrates the knowledge and skills required to collect and document data related to physical, psychosocial and developmental stages and complete interventions according to CT Scan procedures
- Communicates with parent/guardian/significant other regarding procedural issues and/or concerns based on level of comprehension, understanding and readiness to learn
- Maintains a safe environment utilizing appropriate equipment and safety devices, based on the patient's age and level of cognition
- Performs CT Scan procedures utilizing approaches and equipment appropriate to the patient's age and size
- Provides educational support based on patient's CT Scan procedure
- Demonstrates knowledge and skills of radiation safety parameters pertinent to CT Scan procedures
