Responsibilities for site security

- Oversee the plant's security force to ensure surveillance and patrol
- Partner with the contract security agency
- Assist the Technical Services Department in Fire Emergency Response striving for continuous improvement and growth
- Security representative for the Emergency Response Team
- Communicate effectively with internal and external customers, team members
- Respond to calls reference difficult, disruptive, or threatening persons, de-escalate such situations, and make appropriate notifications to Human Resources, Workplace Violence Team, Investigations, and law enforcement
- A Site Supervisor supports operations for remotely managed accounts by performing on-site supervision of Security Professionals (SPs) and ensuring site coverage at all times
- Contribute thought leadership and counsel in all areas of safety, security, and privacy as it relates to the company and executives
- Maintain living database of security incidents and threats
- Work with government agencies to foster and maintain a positive working relationship (local, state, and federal)

Qualifications for site security
