Responsibilities for specialist, research

- May supervise, monitor or coordinate work of subordinates
- Coordinates and/or conducts library and computer searches for research or archaeological data, some of which may include specialized archival research
- Operates and maintains laboratory and experimental equipment such as microtomes, microscopes, electron microscopes, spectrophotometers, centrifuges, analytical balances, photometers, spectrometers and vacuum and optical coating systems
- Performs complex necropsies and surgical procedures on research animals
- Biochemistry – Western blot, immunoprecipitations, ELISA
- Assist in fabrication of sample delivery devices in the biophysics laboratories of the BioXFEL program
- Assist in writing reports on aspects for large archaeological projects
- Coordinate and/or conduct library and computer searches for research or archaeological data, some of which may include specialized archival research
- Synthesis of carbon-11 and fluorine-18 labeled compounds
- Automated radiosynthesis using commercial radiochemistry apparatus
