Responsibilities for sterilization technician

- Assemble customer data packets
- Update inventory management system as product is move throughout our facility
- Red line and ECO SOP's and specifications
- Troubleshoot REVOX equipment
- Execute qualification and validation protocols
- Must have good analytical skills and should be detailed-oriented
- Must be able to work in a team and follow deadlines
- Distribute clean linen to all departments within SCCA, which includes unloading bulk linen carts, stocking shelves, handles special requests, and stocks special linen carts for various areas and departments
- Receives incoming un-processed product, verifies customer count and lot numbers, notes any damage and enters information into the computer system
- Reports any quality and safety issues to the QA manager, or designated supervisor

Qualifications for sterilization technician

- Associate Degree from a vocational school or technical college of at least 1800 hours
- Ability to utilize Microsoft Office Products to generate graphs and data

- Must have schedule flexibility and be able to work 630pm-630am (rotating 4 days on, 4 days off)
- Educational experience equivalent to a High School Diploma with five years previous technician experience, or an Associate's Degree with three years previous technician experience, or a Bachelor's Degree with one year experience
- Two years previous sterile processing experience, instrument room, or central supply experience in an acute care setting with comparable patient mix (trauma, open heart, total joint replacement, complex neuro procedures)
