Responsibilities for storage administrator

- Individuals will be required to work non-core hours from time-to-time in support of Deployments, Co-op operations or in response to Critical outages
- Responsible for support tools, processes, and policies for storage networks and storage services
- Provide stable and reliable operations of the storage environments
- Administer and maintain NetApp's SnapManager suite of backup and recovery tools such as Snap Manager for Exchange, SharePoint, MS SQL and Oracle
- Experience shall include installation, configuration, and networking of UNIX and/or NT based platforms
- Individual shall have a fundamental understanding of operating systems and be familiar with either UNIX or NT commands or utilities at the user level
- Experience shall include the installation and configuration of hardware, operating systems, and commercial software packages
- Individual shall be to develop and implement enterprise backup/recover strategies, server configuration and consolidation, and verification of the health and status of the entire IT infrastructure
- Individual shall be able to provide support for enterprise services such as DNS, NFS, email services, security protection mechanisms, and the interoperability of UNIX and NT based systems
- Lead/coordinate projects including new installations, upgrades, retrofits
