Responsibilities for supplier quality engineering

- Establish mechanisms that support decision making for sourcing, evaluation and selection of suppliers to be placed on the Approved Supplier List and for selection on a contract by contract basis
- Establish standard, risk based methods to validate suppliers conform to requirements
- Establish and maintain a continuous quality improvement program with suppliers
- Significant Travel may be required for short periods of time
- Gap Analysis on PPAP (Production Part Approval)
- Develop and implement scalable process, procedures for inspection, testing, evaluating the precision, reliability and accuracy of products and processes of suppliers
- Translates engineering manufacturing and quality requirements and implements procedures for inspection, testing, evaluating the precision, reliability and accuracy of products and processes of suppliers
- Ensures that project and or process control documentation is compliant with requirements
- Lead and resolves technical, manufacturing, quality issues with the supplier and coordinate with the appropriate stakeholders
- Works with suppliers to refine and enhance products and processes by applying continuous improvement and key lean manufacturing/production

Qualifications for supplier quality engineering

- Desired minimum understanding of manufacturing principles and technical specifications to support facilities and supplier competencies – machining and manufacturing processes, tool design, injection molding, welding, soldering, plating, painting, die cast molding
- Bachelor or Master of Engineering /Science degree is required
- Ability to implement strategies to control the company's supplier quality and supplier development to assure an adequate source of service and supply
- Knowledge and participation in Six Sigma activities, including participation in Kaizen, Value Stream Mapping (VSM) and other continuous improvement activities
- Ability to effectively present information and respond to questions from groups of managers, vendors, customers, and company employees
- Willingness to travel domestic or international travel
