Responsibilities for survey party chief

- Some office technical survey work may be required in this position
- Independently performs surveying assignments, making exact measurements, and providing data relevant to the shape, contour, location, elevation and dimension of land or land features
- Operates and maintains all instruments and measuring devices including levels, robotic total stations, GPS equipment and data collectors
- Transfers survey data to the proper files in the computer network and acquires data for field use
- Loads vehicles with tools and equipment, ensuring materials are loaded correctly
- May be required to drive company or personal vehicle to reach jobsites
- Responsible for safe operation and maintenance of vehicles, tools, and equipment
- May assist in preparation of survey drawings using AutoCAD software
- Effective communicating with Project Manager as to progress updates, scope changes, HSSE reporting and other project impacts
- This position does not have any direct supervisory responsibilities

Qualifications for survey party chief
