### Responsibilities for technical instructor

- Analyze and define content for new training courses
- Test, maintain and upgrade with quality and detail training materials
- Review and edit training materials with quality and detail
- Prepare and setup for training courses (materials and classroom)
- Investigate new and alternative delivery models for training courses
- Identify and implement training techniques and course improvements
- Stay current on development activities and features/functionality of new releases
- Apply advanced technical knowledge to create, maintain, and teach technical training courses on Appliqué and Large Unmanned Ground Systems/Unmanned Ground Vehicles (ALUGS/UGV) robotics systems
- Technical curriculum may involve topics of electronics, welding, or more highly technical areas such as radio and electronics repair or operation of weapons systems
- Use a computer to organize and draft a curriculum that breaks a complex subject into blocks or units of instruction

### Qualifications for technical instructor

- Must be qualified to conduct basic operator training for Force Twenty One Battle Command Brigade and Below-Blue Force Tracker (FBCB2-BFT)
- Must be qualified to conduct basic operator training for Command Post of the Future (CPoF)

- Must be registered in the ATCTS (Army Training Certification Tracking System) at commencement of services
- Minimum HS graduate, Bachelor's Degree preferred
- Ability to accept guidance and follow instructions
