 - Undertake analysis, diagnostic and facilitation activities to identify and assess the requirements interviews, workshops, data collection
 - Work closely with Product Managers to specify the scope of the solutions that will be taken forward for estimation and release planning
 - Coordinate the Development teams to determine appropriate solutions to meet the requirements and size the solutions for release planning purposes
 - Elaborate approved features into clear and complete epics and user stories following the Agile Scrum methodology
 - Define the acceptance criteria that will serve as a benchmark to determine that the new feature/capability is fit for release
 - Manage and maintain the requirements repository for accurate reporting
