- Migrate documents from Author-it to Flare system
- Import and format documents with an eye for detail

- Knowledge on context-sensitive help, integrating online help is preferred
- Work with Engineering Development team to re-enable help contextual links
- Interact with Documentation, Product Management and Engineering teams
