Responsibilities for technician, operations

- Identifying and reporting to the Control Room Operator/Lead Operations
 Technician any plant/equipment malfunction
- Identifying and responding to plant operating outside normal parameters and carrying out the necessary action to correct the abnormality, reporting actions to the Control Room
- Maintaining and being aware of all works being performed on the installation, which may have an impact on the normal and safe operation of the plant, including awareness of all active permits to work issued and accepted
- Completing pre & post start-up/operating checks
- Gathering and collecting data for the process and utility equipment,
 identifying actions to be taken to minimise equipment and machinery failure
- Performs cleanup duties at equipment areas, workstations
- Maintenance and preventative maintenance of studios
- Works with the regional control room to set up and test remote studio productions
- Facilitate live productions
- Facilitate in studio guests

Qualifications for technician, operations

- Valid driver's license and acceptable driving record may be required
- Under general supervision, performs calculations and preliminary analyses for

- Works under direct supervision, but displays initiative and moves toward requiring less supervision
- Ability to read and interpret mechanical drawings, assembly and detail drawings, isometric drawings, plan and elevation drawings, P&IDs, and Bills of Material (BOMs)
- Ability to work with others, good attention to details, and follows work rules
