Responsibilities for technician pharmacy

- Pharmacy Technician will report directly to the Pharmacy Technician Supervisor
 - Pharmacy Technician will be responsible for the tasks of preparing and dispensing medications
 - Pharmacy Technician must be proficient with data entry and computer systems
 - This position takes in-coming calls from members, providers, etc providing professional phone assistance to all callers through the criteria based prior authorization process
 - Maintains complete, timely and accurate documentation of all approvals and denials, and transfers all clinical questions and judgment calls to the pharmacist
 - Determines appropriateness for medications
 - Communicates selected prior authorization criteria, pharmacy benefit coverage and formulary alternatives to physicians, physician's office staff, medical management staff and/or pharmacists
 - Escalates requests to Pharmacist when request requires extensive clinical review or denial
 - Researches, resolves and documents physician or client inquiries and grievances and provides verbal or written results to client, prescriber, provider and/or management
 - High degree of professionalism, must be able to successfully interact with pharmacy teams and members of field leadership
