Responsibilities for technician pharmacy

- Perform the physical/functional requirements of the position
- Communicate effectively and appropriately with pharmacists, nurses, pharmacy technicians, dietitians, billing, and external customers to facilitate accurate, safe care for the patient
- Use automated compounding devices
- Track expiration dates of medications and solutions
- Sterile and accurate admixture of IV products under a laminar flow hood or vertical flow biological safety cabinet which includes reconstitution of drugs, calculation of drug volumes required to deliver correct dosages, measurements of dosages, transfer of drugs to appropriate volumes and types of solutions for administration, and labeling products according to policy
- Clean and maintain laminar flow hood and biological safety cabinet in accordance with applicable standards and laws including The Joint Commission and USP 797
- Assist the pharmacist in all aspects of the departmental operation
- Filling and maintain of the unit-dose, patient medication cassettes, IV admixture, floorstock, and drug inventory systems
- Perform relevant tasks including repackaging, compounding, record keeping, billing, clerical functions, and other tasks as assigned
- Participate in quality assurance and performance improvement activities, departmental education and training
