Responsibilities for technician, process

- Review cGMP Documentation
- Assist in providing information to Transfer Tech and Validation Crew on investigations
- Assist work team in the achievement of goals/commitments and achieves own goals/commitments regardless of obstacles
- Assist the Production Supervisor/Lead in meeting scheduling requirements
- Assist in break coverage as needed
- Perform process equipment troubleshooting, minor repairs and improvements, utilizing appropriate processes and disciplines
- Performs minor repairs, improvements and preventative maintenance utilizing proper procedures, processes and disciplines
- As required, initiates and participate in root cause investigations
- Clears and isolate equipment as required and issues Safe Work Permits for maintenance and project work
- Acts as a resource for other technicians on job tasks and prioritization on work activities

Qualifications for technician, process

- Good technical skills with the ability to conduct basic site maintenance when required
- Ability to work with multi-disciplined shift teams across various areas of a large site
