Responsibilities for technician, quality assurance

- Lead investigations of quality issues reported from all sources such as customer service, warranty and suppliers
- Support Quality Supervisor in reporting and communication of issues to suppliers' CAR/PAR process and verification of effectiveness
- Perform detailed product inspection and testing as needed to applicable regulations and standards for all product categories
- Prepare quality data for supplier and customer audits for internal purposes
- Assist with QC wet chemistry, from grape to finished wine, as requested by winemaking team
- Advise bottling personnel in quality control issues
- Communication (Material Safety Data Sheets) program and internal audits
- Provide QA support to expanding range of Product Lines
- Operate Device Calibration Process
- Help with routine Plant Maintenance activity

Qualifications for technician, quality assurance

- Ability to become competent in operational systems such as Lab, MRP and Warehouse
- Knowledgeable in cGMP requirements as it relates to a topical OTC manufacturing laboratory

- Calibrations of instruments and standardization of solutions
- Ability to test in an organized approach (grouping like test) to maximize testing efficiency
- Ability to interpret test data and report suspect findings to the Chemist/Advisor
