Responsibilities for therapist occupational

- Recommends changes in patients' work or living environments, consistent with their needs and capabilities
- Develops and participates in health promotion programs, group activities, or discussions to promote client health, facilitate social adjustment, alleviate stress, and prevent physical or mental disability
- Consults with rehabilitation team to select activity programs and coordinate occupational therapy with other therapeutic activities
- Plans and implements programs and social activities to help patients adjust to handicaps
- Follows the procedures and policies of the department
- Plan and conduct individualized occupational therapy programs in a home care environment to help patients develop, regain, or maintain their ability to perform daily activities
- Teach patients skills/techniques and how to use adaptive equipment for participating in activities
- Study, evaluate, and record patients' activities and progress
- Evaluate and assess patient's functional status
- Develop realistic, functional goals mutually agreed upon with the patient / family

Qualifications for therapist occupational

- Attend 3.0 CEU every 2 years

- Graduation from a school of occupational therapy approved by the American Occupational Therapy Association required
- One (1) year of pediatric experience required
- Ability to perform duties and make decisions in stressful situations required
