## Responsibilities for travel medical

- Serves as public relations liaison between the volunteers, the travel agency and donors to aid in their understanding of service to mission hospital/clinic in foreign countries comprehensive understanding of World Medical Mission and Samaritan's Purse ministries
- Provides oversight and direction to entire logistical process once volunteers are placed at hospital/clinic
- Sends detailed orientation packets to volunteers
- Assists volunteers in obtaining information regarding workload, call schedules, facility layout, needed supplies and medical equipment
- Manages a wide variety of logistical problems in route, which may include emergencies
- Updates and restructures hospital/clinic orientation materials on an ongoing basis
