Responsibilities for vascular technologist

- Comply with the standards set by the Intersocietal Commission for the Accreditation of Vascular Laboratories (ICAVL) and departmental policies and procedures
- Share regional coverage for stand-by and call back on evenings and weekends
- Assist a physician in performing noninvasive diagnostic and therapeutic cardiovascular procedures
- Performs procedures under the direction of a Radiologist
- Maintain adequate supplies and monitor/verify all equipment is in proper working condition
- Prepares, positions, transfers and informs patients
- Documents and maintains records of examinations
- Schedule patients in a timely and consistent manner
- Compile all paperwork appropriately and in a timely manner
- Obtain, review and utilize all historical information relevant to the procedure being requested

Qualifications for vascular technologist

- Ability to move ultrasound equipment for portable studies to various nursing units
