Responsibilities for vascular technologist

- Assists in gathering and recording Q.A
- Assists in gathering and recording Q.I
- Completes all required documentation for procedures regulatory, billing protocols, and imagine distribution
- Files and/or routes patient results as appropriate
- Assists Senior Registered Vascular Technologist with ICAVL (Intersocietal Commission for Accreditation of Vascular Laboratories) re-accreditation process
