Responsibilities for welding technician

- Fabricate pipe in horizontal (fixed - 5G and rolled - 1G), inclined (fixed - 6G) and vertical (fixed - 2G) positions
- Read, interpret and troubleshoot engineering drawings
- Determine project requirements - scope, assembly sequences, and bill of materials according to engineering drawings and written or verbal instructions
- Calculate the quantity, size, and quality of material required
- Create various ad-hoc reports which may include querying multiple datasets and compiling results in a presentable format
- Bid and quote projects and order all welding materials needed to perform duties
- Also must be able to read and interpret PFD's, P&ID, and be able to draw project diagrams
- Will respond to emergency maintenance requests as required by supervisor
- Demonstrated knowledge of basic electrical
- Provides support to the production inspection requirements
