- Perform in-depth troubleshooting and resolution of servers that have failed the patch install
- Work with Microsoft and other vendor teams to resolve issues
- Run patch reports for new builds and assist in other Windows security remediation
- Must be able to maintain data confidentiality and compliance with regulatory requirements (HIPAA)
- Server Preventive Maintenance
- Manage and Monitor Server Resources
