Responsibilities for windows server administrator

- Design and configure customer-based systems and applications
- Design disaster recovery plans for Operational teams
- Respond and act as Team Manager with same level access and authority when outside groups need manager level approval
- Act as Technical lead to perform conversion of fuel terminals from Modem Bank to network device including working with Networking to obtain IP configuration, apply configuration to the device, and Hardware/Device upgrades on-site at various facilities
- Act as technical Point of Contact to perform application installation and configuration (with or without vendor) and identifying technical solutions to execute the requirements of the business
- Act as Server Administrator to analyze, troubleshoot and resolve operational incidents with large scale systems
- Provide advanced Technical / Analytical support using tools like Splunk for log analysis, and make recommendations for OS, Database and Networking configuration tuning
