- Ongoing documentation of each individual patient's assessments, plan-ofcare, interventions and evaluation of rendered care
- Ability to perform wound assessment, reassessment, and management for all patients and per policy
- Knowledge of the anatomy, physiology, and disorders of the dermal systems, gastrointestinal, and genitourinary
- Utilizes principles of current wound management theory when providing care to patients with acute and chronic wounds

Qualifications for wound care

- Maintain all safety and compliance with the hyperbaric chamber
- Data entry in to the wound information data system and collate reports for leadership

- Perform quality controls daily and maintain department equipment such as glucometers, air and oxygen supplies
- Perform transcutaneous oxygen monitoring testing as ordered and per policy
- Perform dressing changes and/or wound care within scope of practice, as ordered and participate in clinic as necessary
