## Responsibilities for wound care

- Demonstrates knowledge and skill to develop and implement policies and procedures to manage patients with impaired skin integrity
- Ability to revise plan of care as indicated by the patient's response to treatment and evaluate overall plan for effectiveness
- Serves as a resource person to physicians and nursing staff
- Consults other healthcare professionals as appropriate to provide interdisciplinary approach to the patient's needs
- Attends seminars, conferences, and continuing education classes in the areas of wound prevention, wound management, and ostomies
- Completes documentation, including patient education and supply charges, on all wound care patients into computer system in a timely manner to ensure compliance
- Participates in the performance improvement plan of the agency
- Nursing Leadership- representative for assigned committees, meetings, vendor/sales representative liaison, preceptor for new staff, coordination of orientee/student schedules
- Lead product development activities for the Wound Care Franchise, which encompasses Band-Aid and First Aid Brands, from a concept, product design and manufacturability standpoint
- Collaborate cross-functionally with Global Franchise Marketing, R&D Medical/Clinical, Regulatory Affairs, Quality Assurance and Support to Marketed Products to find opportunities, build business cases and perform the work necessary to bring products from concept to market

- Take serial photographs of the wound for reporting of the patient's progress and enter into the electronic medical record
- Assist the registered nurse in coordinating the care of the patient across the continuum of care which could include making of appointments, home care referrals, and triage of phone calls
- Work with appropriate departments to ensure safety of the hyperbaric equipment within the department
- Completion of an accredited LPN education program
- Current State of WI LPN License
- At least 1 year prior experience in a physician office based LPN role strongly preferred
