Responsibilities for youth counselor

- Physical & occupational therapy room
- Sensory therapy rooms
- Neurofeedback therapy programs

- Art room, Gym, outdoor pool, exercise room & outside playgrounds

Qualifications for youth counselor

- You must be legally authorized to work in the U.S. and qualify for a U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Credential (MMC) Transportation Workers Identification Credential (TWIC)
- Extrovert, quick and critical thinker, witty, personable, and articulate
- Ability to live in close quarters
- The U.S. Coast Guard (USCG) requires all crew members employed with NCL America aboard the Pride of America to hold a Merchant Mariner Credential

- Experience working/volunteering with youth, corrections, or police work preferred
- Experience working with at-risk youth a major plus
