Responsibilities for youth leader

- Plan, direct and implement a comprehensive youth ministry with the appropriate leadership
- Provide direct teaching, leadership, and scholarly contributions within a program area like volunteer management
- Link skills building to opportunities where youth can utilize these skills in a tangible manner, including self-employment and entrepreneurship programs, grant-making programs, incentive funds, development of new sectors, the facilitation of public and private alliances, and establishment of linkages private sector funding such as angel investors or venture capital firms
- Identify and supervise Short Term Technical Advisers (STTA) in fields such as youth life skills development and economic skills development, to support program implementation
- Identify resilience partners and actors within the area of responsibility where program objectives can be met for mobilizing youth to be positive forces for change
- Oversee youth-led activities, including analyses of local problems and development of their solutions
- Work with local staff and their target groups and populations to conceptualize and develop local youth-led activities aimed at bringing about positive change
- Be responsible for adult supervision, training and recruitment of adult volunteers for youth-related activities
- Be in attendance at all youth activities and programs or insure that qualified adults are designated
